### Equal Participation Analysis

Data from the Spokane Tribe of Indians and the Colville Confederated Tribe were collected to show participation in all programs for the Columbia School District #206. The data continues to demonstrate that gap does not exist in any particular program; however, the sample size is extremely small and makes data analysis difficult. The Superintendent and K-12 Principal have made the following conclusions about gaps: 1. Indian children participate in athletics at a rate equal to or higher than their non-Indian counterparts; 2. No significant differences in academic achievement among Indian / non-Indian children; 3. Disciplinary action (suspensions have been very few and make generalizations difficult); 4. Graduation rates showed no gap between Indian / non-Indian children. Greater than 90% of students graduate in 4 years. 5. Greater than 97% of students regularly attend.

The analysis showed that the percentage of Indian children who participated was equal compared to the total percentage of all children who participated.
